Both industry nights serve as opportunities dedicated to Raffles graduating students for them to network with the industry professionals, and showcase their works to renowned organisations.

Leading up to the graduation ceremony on 9 December, the celebration was amped up with more exhibitions from Jewellery Design, Fashion Marketing, Business and Psychology, with top works for Interior Design, Product Design, Animation, Game Design, Graphic Design and Multimedia Design. The night was wrapped up with a well-orchestrated fashion show by 20 of the graduating Raffles Fashion Designers held at Fairmont Hotel Singapore.
